Here are a few ways you can get involved:

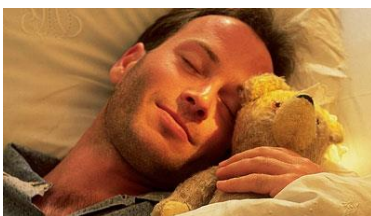
- ❖ Committee Members for a variety of committees such as Fundraising/Development, Public Relations, Affordable Housing, & Special Events

COOKING & EATING: Each evening the families are with us, we provide a nutritious meal for them and join them for dinner providing hospitality and a positive presence. We need people who are willing to cook meals and also people who enjoy sitting down to a meal and being social.

HAVING FUN: After dinner, we have Activity Hosts come join the families for a couple of hours to provide and participate in leisure-time activities. This may include games, doing crafts, playing music, bringing pets to visit...the possibilities are limitless.



SLEEPING: *Seriously...how much easier of a volunteer opportunity is there?*

Each night, two overnight Hosts serve as a presence for our families in case there is an emergency. When the families go to bed, so do you! We provide a bed. You bring a pillow and any special blankie or teddy bear to make you comfortable.

(Bonus...this is the one time a pastor likes for you to sleep in church!)
